

AMGA Single Pitch Instructor Course and Exam Information Red River Gorge, Kentucky

Meeting times and locations subject to change. All students will be notified directly in the case of an amendment to the schedule.

Where: We will meet at the Muir Valley Parking Lot. Address is 48 Muir Road, Rogers, KY 41365. We pay for parking passes for our students! Carpooling is recommended when possible to save on the limited parking in Muir and other locations.

When: We will meet at 9:00AM on the first day. If you have not pre-filled out a Liability Waiver, please arrive at least five minutes early to do so.

What to Bring: Please consult PAGE 5 of your AMGA SPI Program Handbook (available for download on the AMGA Students page of our website). Please bring ALL the required equipment each day of the course or exam. In the case that certain equipment is not required for a particular day, you will be informed that morning. DO NOT plan on sharing equipment.

Camping: Camping is available at the Land of Arches Campground ***Recommended*** (address above, Ph. # (606) 668-7074) or at Miguel's Pizza (Daniel Boone National Forest, 1890 Natural Bridge Rd, Slade, KY 40376, Ph. # (606) 663-1975).

Textbook: If you are interested in purchasing it, however, it is not required by us, the textbook is available for purchase on the AMGA's website at www.amga.com, or on amazon.com. We do not use the textbook during the course at all.

Food/Water: Plan for long days at the cliff. We will not necessarily return to, or be close to vehicles. Pack enough food and water for the entire day; days can sometimes be over eight hours long.

Clothing: Weather is always unpredictable. Prepare for inclement weather, such as rain or cold temperatures. Have enough layers and a rain jacket. **Closed Toed Shoes** are **required.**

Attendance: If for some reason, you are unable to attend, please provide as much notice as possible.
